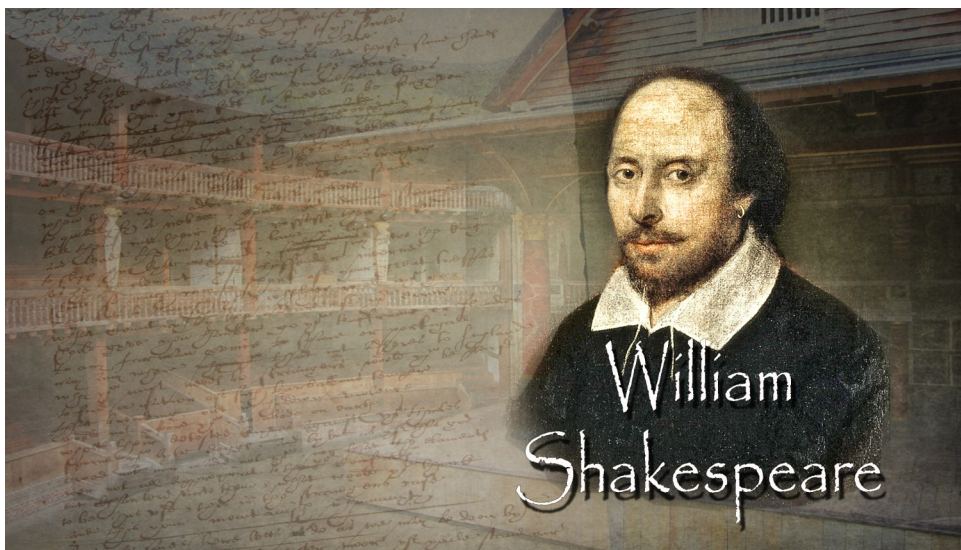

Project description:

Context:

2016 commemorates 400 years since William Shakespeare's death. Through his masterpieces, he is considered one of the fathers of European Culture and Identity.

The project is led and hosted by InCo organisation.

Activities:

Using theatre activities and related notions, young people will have the opportunity to focus on the topic of the **European identity, social inclusion, cultural integration, immigration** and **refugees**.

The participants will take part in events organised by Molfetta municipality and InCO within the local summer festival.

Theatre performance, guided tour, debates, theatre workshops will be the core of the project.

Each group of young people will be in charge of presenting a short theatre performance in English, connected with Shakespeare. They will also need to reach topics such as: social inclusion, diversity, immigration, hospitality, etc.

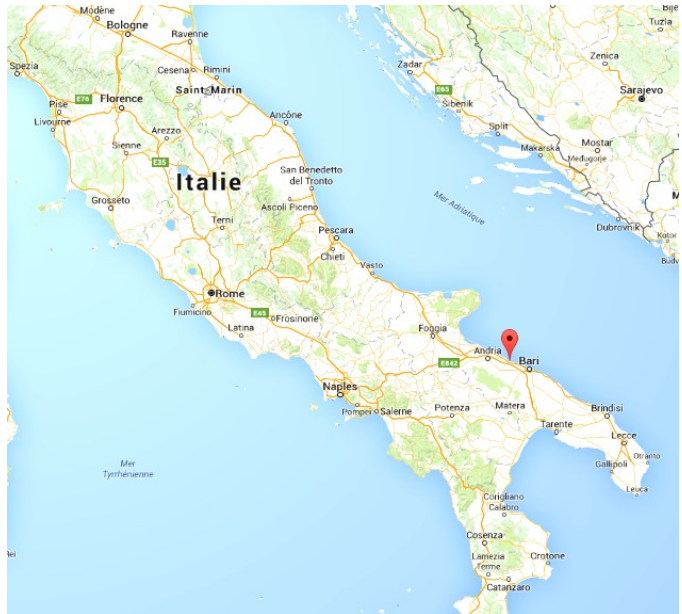
All the activities will be presented during the final event—the summer festival—in the local community.

Objectives:

- To promote the informal process of European integration among the groups of young people and also in a remote community of Southern Italy through theatre
- To develop new non-formal and intercultural competences
- To fight against discrimination and intolerance
- To promote non-formal skills such as: self-confidence, team building, group work, public speaking, self-reflection, new foreign languages, body language, etc.
- To show young people one of the stepping stones of European identity and European root;
- To address the topic of immigration, refugees and diversity through theatre and Shakespeare masterpieces.
- To give participants the opportunity to get positive memories about theatre.
